

Prior to training/match (both home & away):-

- Have fully stocked in date first aid kit
- Appropriately first aid trained person in attendance (minimum Level 1)
- Emergency access is clear & any key needed is readily available (know who/where)
- Know any specific venue procedures
- Ensure contact details of parents/guardians are available for all players
- Be aware of any pre-existing medical conditions. If any medication is required by a player ensure they have this (if not should not be participating)
- Have a charged mobile phone
- Know where the nearest available AED is and how to access this –
What3words ///extend.rift.imprinted
- Ensure all staff are clear on the FA concussion guidelines
- Know where the nearest A&E department is
- Ensure that the relevant PPE is available to comply with FA Covid guidelines

In case of emergency:-

- Follow first aid procedures to assess player (to level of your training)
- Do not move a player if seriously injured, call 999/112
- Record details of any incident occurring and report as necessary

Defibrillator	The club has a portable defibrillator which is kept at the field. All FA licensed coaches have received defibrillator training.

The ground can be accessed from a gate on Salisbury Road; the gate is approx. 200 yards down from the junction with Stony Lane on the left. From here you access the car park and then the football pitches.

Directions to hospital	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) From the Car Park turn left and then first right. 2) Head south on Stony Lane/B3347 for 1.5 miles. 3) At the roundabout, take the 4th exit onto Christchurch Bypass/A35 for ½ mile. 4) At the Fountain Roundabout, take the 4th exit onto Barrack Rd/A35. 5) Stay on Barrack Road for 2 miles. 6) Just after the Iford Bridge Tavern take the 3rd exit onto Castle Lane East. 7) Turn right at the second set of traffic lights and the hospital is on your left.
