

1. Player Membership to the club will be made annually by enrolment in accordance with the applicant's own wishes and with the approval of the Parent or Guardian.
2. An annual subscription fee will be payable (to be determined by the Club committee annually). The subscription covers training, league and cup entries. The subscription will be payable in two equal instalments due by 30th September and 31st January.

NO PLAYER SHALL PLAY A MATCH UNLESS ENROLLED AS A CLUB MEMBER AND REGISTERED WITH THE APPROPRIATE LEAGUE.

3. The subscription charge will be reviewed annually and set at the discretion of the club committee and voted on the AGM. Refunds of subscriptions paid will only be made in exceptional circumstances at the sole discretion of the club committee.
4. If a player's subscription is not paid by the instalment dates above, they will be suspended from club activities until it is paid, unless permission is granted by the Club Management Committee. If the player subscription is not fully paid by the end of the season, they will not be able to become a member of the club the following season until that debt is paid.
5. Training will be arranged at the discretion of the team management in preparation for and during the league season, for cup competitions and tournaments.
6. Team selection will be made by the team manager in line with the club's constitution.
7. Matches will normally be played on Sunday afternoons for 11 – 16 age groups and Sunday mornings for Mini Soccer.
8. Players are expected to attend fund raising events and competitions in order to ensure the future of the club.
9. Players must provide their own football BOOTS and SHIN GUARDS for training and matches. (wearing of shin guards is compulsory and the responsibility of the player)
10. The club will not be responsible for injuries to players or damage/loss of personal property.
11. Players will be required to register with the Football Association of who's league their team has entered. This will be valid for this particular season only. Once registered, with the exception of school's teams, players cannot register or play with another team without confirmation from the Club Committee that no relevant rules/policies will be broken.
12. The Football Association may request proof of a player's age and identity and may summon a parent or guardian to a disciplinary hearing if a player is suspended of breaking Football association rules.
13. Payment for any fines incurred by a player through their own fault will be requested of the player's parent or guardian.
14. Players will abide by the Burton Youth Football Club code of conduct.
15. Burton Youth Football Club subscribes to the FA code of conduct and respect campaign. Players, parents/guardians and coaches are required to have read the requirements of this code of conduct and by signing, agree to the conduct terms.
16. At times the club may wish to take photos or videos of teams or individuals for promotion of the club or training g purposes. Permission to this is sought on the Club membership and consent form.
