CHAIRMANS COMMENTS

Hello and welcome to the Burton Youth Football Club (BYFC) Newsletter for 2023. A lot has happened since our last newsletter and the Club has moved on.

We are currently running teams from u6 to u16, with the exception of u15. We have approximately 160 children signed up and actively taking part in organised football activities. We have somewhere between 20 and 30 regular volunteers, who put extraordinary amounts of time and effort into providing a safe environment for local children to play the game we love.

This issue will concentrate on probably the most important part of Youth football—Safeguarding. This may sound like a strange comment but the purpose of safeguarding is to provide that safe environment, where our kids can flourish.

One of our matches was recently subject of an unannounced spot check by the Hampshire FA Safeguarding team. The visit went well, with the team commenting that the coaches were confident in responding to safeguarding scenarios and most importantly all the players appeared engaged and were enjoying themselves. Whilst the visit went well, we haven't got it cracked and have some learning points, which we will be putting in place over the coming weeks.

As I have said our coaches and volunteers put in a huge amount of time and effort to their roles. Can I make a personal plea to all of you? Please make their role as easy as possible, there are so many ways you can do this—be it replying to messages promptly, turning up on time, making prompt payments, reinforcing the teams ethos through positive support, helping setting up or take down pitches. Being a parent is hard work but the majority of these coaches have to parent and coach, so any assistance you can give will be greatly appreciated.

We have a great club, with great volunteers, players and parents but we always strive to improve. So with your help we look forward to taking BYFC forward.

CHRISTCHURCH TOWN COUNCIL FUNDING

The club was recently successful in a funding request from the Community Grant Fund.

We applied for £820 to assist us in providing the BYFC coaches with the relevant FA qualifications.

The clubs aim is to have two FA qualified coaches per age group. This funding has allowed us to do this with the u9s, u11s, u12s and u13s all having a coach put through the FAs Introduction to Coaching football course.

Further to this, the funding has allowed us to put two coaches (James Petty and Will Deans) through the FA UEFA C licence. Once qualified these coaches own teams will benefit greatly but they will also be asked to share their knowledge throughout the club, benefiting everyone.

BYFC have matched the Council's money as we strongly believe that investing in our Coaches benefits the whole community.

I wanted to reiterate Andy's comments regarding the recent visit from Hampshire FA Safeguarding Team by thanking all of the coaches and volunteers for their help in ensuring we received positive feedback from them. There is still work to be done though, and as a club we are committed to ensuring that Burton Youth will continue to provide a safe environment for children to enjoy playing football. Your involvement as parents and carers could help with promoting this ethos; by completing this new 30 minute course, set up by the FA, which aims to create greater awareness of the safeguarding role parents and carers can play within football, will help to achieve this. Payment can be made at anytime but there are two dates of importance.


The first half of the subscriptions must be paid by the last Sunday in September (24/09/2023)

SAFEGUARDING ISSUES

Safeguarding children is everyone's responsibility.

The club welfare officers have a responsibility for ensuring that children and young people, who register with Burton Youth FC, can play football in a safe and non-threatening environment, and are not subject to any form of neglect, abuse or bullying.

If you are worried about a child it is important that you report your concerns using the guidelines below—inaction is not an option.

Contact the Burton Youth FC Welfare Officer, Will Deans on 07583193785.

If the issue is one of poor practice the Welfare Officer will either deal with the matter themselves or seek advice from the Hampshire FA Designated Safeguarding Officer.

If the concern is more serious - possible child abuse - where possible, contact the Hampshire FA Designated Safeguarding Officer (Shantelle Woodward—Safeguarding@HampshireFA.com) first, then immediately contact the Police or Children's Services .

If the child needs immediate medical treatment take them to a hospital or call an ambulance and tell them this is a child protection concern. Let your Club Welfare Officer know what action you have taken.

If at any time you are not able to contact your Club Welfare Officer or the matter is serious then you can either:

Contact your Hampshire FA Designated Safeguarding Officer directly, Call The FA/NSPCC 24 hour Helpline for advice on 0808 800 5000 or online Contact the Police on 999 or Children's Services

RESPECT

We all bear a collective responsibility to set a good example and help provide a positive environment in which children can learn and enjoy the game. Play your part and observe The FA's Respect Code of Conduct .

There are individual codes of conduct for Players, Coaches/Team Managers/Club Officials and Spectators. They can be found on our website. As part of the Clubs signing on process these forms will be circulated to you and make a declaration for yourself and on behalf of the players that you have read and understood them.

Failure to abide by these codes can result in sanctions as detailed on the website.


